- ♦ This papercraft can make an ornament of the jack-o'-lantern or a mask from common parts. In addition, the face of the jack-o'-lantern prepares for three kinds.
- The assembly instructions are divided into four sections: A(jack-o'-lantern, options 1 to 3), B (jack-o'-lantern, as an ornament and a mask), C (jack-o'-lantern, as an ornament), and D (witch hat and bat wings). Refer to the appropriate section of the instructions as you assemble your papercraft.
- If you are making a mask, you will not need the C parts.

#### <Caution>

- \*Keep scissors and glue away from small children.
- \*Be careful not to cut your fingers when using scissors.
- \*This jack-o'-lantern is not intended for use as an actual lantern. For your own safety, do not put candles or light bulbs inside it.
- \*When you put the mask on, your field of vision may be restricted. Be careful not to trip or bump into things!
- \*When putting the mask on, be careful not to scrape the skin on your neck or fingers.

The lanterns we make out of pumpkins at Halloween are called "jack-o'-lanterns," their origin lying in the legend of Jack, a man who, having led a depraved existence, was refused entry to the afterlife when he died. Jack is said to wander around holding a lantern made from a turnip, with a glowing piece of coal inside that he was given by the devil. Jack-o'-lanterns were originally made from turnips, but in America, people began to use pumpkins as they tend to last longer. It is also believed that jack-o'-lanterns, the symbol of Halloween, are effective at attracting good spirits and repelling the bad.


